

2022 Dennehy Ceili Costume Agreement

Dancers Name: _____

This Agreement is between the undersigned parent or guardian (the “Renter”) of a dancer (the “Dancer”) and the Dennehy School of Irish Dance Parent’s Club (the “Owner”) for rental of a team Costume (the “Costume”).

Scope of Rental.

- The Costume rented is identified as Dress# _____ Headband # _____ for dancer
- The Costume includes: _____ X _____ Costume, cape, and headband
- **Rental Fee.** The rental fee for the Costume is:
 - **\$150.00** The ceili competition only at the 2022 Autumn Feis (not to be worn for solos) and the 2022 Midwest Oireachtas which is being held in Indianapolis, IN
- **Terms of Payment.** Payment of the rental fee prior to the Renter taking custody of the Costume. Personal check, certified or cashier’s check, money order or cash will be accepted.
- **Care of the Costume.** The Dancer may wear the Costume for the indicated competition(s), including for official team pictures and for presentation of awards. The Costume shall not be worn for solo competition at feisanna, or by any dancer other than the Dancer listed in this Agreement.
 - The Dancer shall apply tanner, before putting on the Costume, and allow time for tanner to dry.
 - The Dancer shall not eat anything or drink anything but water while in the Costume.
 - Do not use duct tape, masking tape, gaffer’s tape, iron-on hemp tape, or any other sticky adhesive on the Costume. If safety pins are used, do not leave them in the Costume after wearing as they may damage the fabric.
 - Do not dry clean, wash, or dry the Costume. If any item must be cleaned, the Owner’s will clean it at the Renter’s expense.
 - Dancer may only put on the Costume right before going side stage for a competition and must take it off and immediately return it to the dress bag after dancing.
 - The Costume should stay properly stored in a costume bag when it is not being worn and kept in a safe area.
 - The Costume shall be transported in a dress bag by the Renter to the Feis and the Nationals. If flying, the Costume shall be a carry on item in a dress bag, and carefully stored in the overhead bin on the plane. **The Costume should not be checked in a suitcase**
- **Return Date.** The Costume and crown must be returned to the owner at a designated location with all its component parts no later than two weeks after the 2022 Midwest Oireachtas. It shall be returned in accordance with information provided by Owner on the return schedule. The Owner will inspect the Costume with the Renter.
- **Loss of and/or Damage of the Costume.** Reasonable wear and tear is to be expected, but any damage such as rips, tears and stains will be charged a repair fee to the Renter. The Renter and Dancer are financially responsible for this dress while it is in their possession. In the case of a lost Costume or damage that cannot be repaired, the Renter will owe the parent’s club the full cost of the damaged/lost items (costume and cape = approximately \$650, headband = \$15).

 - a. Black bottom ghillies (soft shoes) for competition – any brand
 - b. A wig that matches my hair color (U10 & U12 TTC will wear the Kaera Double Curl Bun; U15's and U19's will wear the Robyn Luxe Full Wig)
 - c. Royal Blue Satin Spankies (aka bloomers, dance pants, etc)
 - d. Kathleen Sassy Poodle socks \$20 / Silky Toes Microfiber Tights \$21.50 for 2 pairs
